THE AIRPORT

THE RAILWAY STATION

The port of Bari is one of the largest ports on the Adriatic sea and is traditionally considered Europe's door to the Balkan Peninsula and the Middle East.

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

GENERAL INFORMATION

The official language is English.

The author has to propose the specific topic each of his abstract deals with.

The presentation of the accepted abstract can be made (on authors choice) as

- short oral presentation (e-poster): three slides, two minutes time
or
- full oral presentation: max twelve slides, twelve minutes time for presentation and three minutes time for discussion.

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

1. Abstracts have to be no more than one page long and almost 400 words.
2. There is no limit to the number of abstracts that each author may present.
3. The final abstract file has to be named (regardless for its extension) as follow:
proposed topic (two digits) - Dash - First Author's family name - Underscore - First Author's first name initial (one character) (NN-Author_A.docx)
4. The final abstract file has to be sent by e-mail to the address abstractsubmission@aiaa2017.it
5. The abstract must be written in English using Microsoft Word® compatible format, with the following typographic specification:

Line spacing: single

Font family, style and dimension - Paragraph formatting

Header: Times New Roman, Italics, 10pt - Left aligned;

Title: Times New Roman, Bold, 14pt - Left aligned;

Author's name(s): Times New Roman, Normal, 12pt (comma separated if more than one) - Left aligned;

Author's affiliation: Times New Roman, Italics, 10pt (no more than two separate line) - Left aligned;

Corresponding author name and e-mail address: Times New Roman, Bold-Italics, 10pt - Left aligned;

Keywords: Times New Roman, Bold, 12pt - Left aligned;

Body titles: Times New Roman, Bold, 12pt - Left aligned;

Body: Times New Roman, Normal, 12pt - Justified

GUIDELINES FOR EXTENDED ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Guidelines for paper submission will be available after notification of abstract acceptance (March 15, 2017)

GUIDELINES FOR ORAL/SHORT ORAL PRESENTATION

Short oral presentation slideshow must be made of three slides (title, contents, results). Full oral presentation slideshow must be made of maximum twelve slides (title, materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusions).

The guidelines for both short and full oral presentation format will be available after extended abstracts submission (May 31, 2017) as well as final file delivery instruction.
